Please outline the following; (maximum 3 pages - 8.5 x 11", double-spaced typewritten pages)

- a) Describe what you would like to develop for engaging youth in the process of your art practice. Include ideas, visions and creative concepts that you think could be part of your residency. Also, present one or two ideas that would help make the Artist in Residence Program financially sustainable.
- b) Outline the possible lasting effects of your residency. For example the youth community engaged has a new understanding of creative processes and practices.
- c) Timeline of project
- d) What you will need for studio, meeting or exhibition spaces. All requests to book studio, meeting or exhibition space must respect ongoing programming at the Arts Centre at Cedar Hill but spaces will be made available free of charge to the program. Limited access for storage.
- e) Project Budget of \$6000 which outlines artist fee, materials, and partial cost recovery.
